



DIAS 2017 REQUIREMENTS

DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS: June 20, 2017

1. **Application Form** (www.diasedu.com)
 - a. Submit to Dias via email or by mail as soon as possible
2. **Course Description:**
 - a. Please Indicate up to two courses. First and Second choice must be filled out and pre-approved by your home university.
3. **Course Pre-Approval**
 - a. Submit Course choices to home university with Dias program information, syllabus of each course(s) and the Professors curriculum vitae. Have both Choice 1 and 2 signed for pre-approval. **Obtain a letter of pre-approval for both first and second choice sets and make sure that the credits earned will be transferrable from the University of Crete.**
 - b. All grades and credits will be forwarded to your University upon graduation from the University of Crete provided that you give us all the information.
4. **Copy of Your Health Insurance Coverage**
5. **Copy of Your International Student ID card (ISIC) Optional**
 - a. An ISIC can be obtained from your University or at www.isic.org
6. **Accident Insurance Coverage**
 - a. Economic accident insurance can be obtained together with the International Student ID card upon request
7. **A recent photo ID**
8. **Copy of your passport**
9. **Payment should be in the form of Certified Check or Money Order for program fee of \$2,500 to be paid in full upon application. Payment shall be made to: DIAS International Academic Studies Program, 18 West View Drive, Upper Brookville, NY 11771 (516) 606-0533. Applications and payments must be sent via **Federal Express**.**
10. **NOTE** airfare to and from NY-ATHENS-CRETE round trip are the responsibility of the student.

NOTES:

DIAS International Studies Program has the right to cancel the program if they do not get the sufficient amount of students to fulfill the courses until June 30, which is the deadline of the applications. A minimum of 10 students per class is required. The host University bears no responsibility for these consequences. Also note that your participation fee goes entirely towards the expenses of the program. A full refund will be returned to you only if the program is cancelled.
